

Deadline Approaching for Pennsylvania EITC/OSTC Tax Credit Program

If you participate in the EITC/OSTC tax credit program through your business, see below for application deadlines. If you do not participate in the program but are interested, please contact us for more information.

Second Year of a Two Year Commitment:

C-corporations and Pass-through entities can submit their applications from May 15, 2019 through June 30, 2019.

Renewal of a New Two Year Commitment:

Businesses that have fulfilled their 2-year commitment and wish to reapply in fiscal year 2019/2020 can also submit their application from May 15, 2019 through June 30, 2019.

First Year Applicants:

C-corporations and Pass-through entities can submit their applications on July 1, 2019. These applications are approved on a first-come, first-served basis.

Important Note:

The EITC/OSTC credit program is not limited to business owners. Individuals can donate through the Special Purpose Entity (SPE) program. If you are a Pennsylvania residents paying PA individual income taxes, you can share in the savings!
